Gregg-Clarke Park and City of Kyle James Adkins Pool

In the mid-1990s, the Gregg and Clarke families made sure that the community of Kyle had a park large enough to provide recreational activities and special events. Today, the Kyle Pool anchors the multi-use park and other amenities, including lit multiple softball and football fields, lit basketball and tennis courts, a covered pavilion, covered playscapes, walking trails and wide open spaces.

Lake Kyle Park and Home of the Parks and Recreation Office

There are four Nature Trails using four different types of surfaces totaling over 4 miles at Lake Kyle. This means there is a little something for everyone. These trails have colored trail post markers keeping you on track. Bring your hiking boots, cross-country shoes, mountain bike, walking stick and bottle of water and give them a try.

Mary Kyle Hartson City Square Park

Mary Kyle Hartson City Square Park is in the heart of Kyle, Texas. It features a beautiful pavillion and a fountain and equipment for the children to play on.

Steeplechase Park and Steeplechase Dog Park

Located at Lehman Rd. and Hailee Dr., this park features 31 acres of open spaces with the picturesque Plum Creek running through the heart of it. Steeplechase Park has several access points from the north and south of Plum Creek. Park amenities include covered pavilion, playscapes, trails, baseball and football fields, basketball and sand volleyball courts and a championship disc golf course. This location is also home to the city's public dog park: Steeplechase Dog Park

Waterleaf Park

628 Abundance Lane Kyle, TX 78640

Located on the far eastern side of Kyle with the Plum Creek running through the property, 70 of the 92 acres are still undeveloped and remain in the natural condition. The 20 acres that are developed include baseball and soccer fields, playscape, nature trails and wide open spaces.
